Objective

The purpose of an internship is to provide an opportunity for students to gain industry experience with great offer of internships in top tier investment and private banks in Switzerland and Europe. Many of these offers are provided by the Swiss Finance Institute to which the finance professors are affiliated.

Description

The internship should have as content a practical problem and Students should previously acquired academic knowledge to propose and possibly implement a solution. Students may take on internships lasting a minimum of 3 months (12 weeks), within the same department. A partial time cannot be considered as an internship. Only one internship can be recognized on the master.

Students have the possibility to validate their Internship for 15 ECTS as courses electives. Students have to write an Internship thesis. Internship Thesis should identify the problem, identify alternative solutions, propose one solution, and then indicate how the proposed solution should be implemented within the company or the financial institution in which your internship took place. It is most important that the student demonstrate in this thesis deep understanding of the received body of academic knowledge pertaining to the domain of his or her studies.

Assessment

Continuous assessment

Internship Thesis will be evaluated by professor, supervising the thesis and, if necessary, with the host company during an oral presentation. The intern will keep his/her Supervisor Professor posted about his/her internship. He/she will have to discuss with the professor at least twice during the internship.
